<u>Corn earworm</u>: Corn earworm moth activity remains very low levels across all trapping

locations consistent with lower temperatures.

**Beet armyworm:** BAW activity decreased slightly in most areas, but moth captures remain

steady in the many trap locations. Activity is quite a bit lower than this

time last season.

<u>Cabbage looper:</u> Cabbage looper moth activity remains light compared to last year, but

has increased in the Dome and Gila Valleys.

<u>Whitefly</u> Adult movement is very low consistent with cooler temperatures.

Thrips Thrips movement is on the decline in all areas, and at very low levels.

Aphids: Aphid movement has decreased over the past two weeks, but were

active captured in the Gila and Yuma Valley.

Leafminers Adult activity is low at all trapping locations.
